1.
$$\sum_{k=1}^{\infty} \frac{k^2 + 1}{k^2 \sqrt{k}}$$

$$2. \sum_{k=1}^{\infty} \frac{k^2 + 1}{k^3 \sqrt{k}}$$

3.
$$\sum_{n=1}^{\infty} \frac{n(n+2)2^n}{3^n}$$

$$4. \sum_{n=0}^{\infty} \frac{4n+25}{5n+10}$$

5.
$$\sum_{n=1}^{\infty} \frac{(-1)^n}{n^2 + 1}$$

6.
$$\sum_{j=1}^{\infty} \frac{1}{j^3}$$
 (no *p*-series knowledge allowed for this one).

7.
$$\sum_{k=0}^{\infty} \frac{5k+10}{25k^2+54k+87}$$

8.
$$\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} \frac{n!}{1000^n}$$

9.
$$\sum_{m=1}^{\infty} \frac{(-1)^n 4^n (n+2)}{(n+1)! 2^n}$$

10.
$$\sum_{k=0}^{\infty} \frac{1}{2^k + 5}$$
